Note of the meeting



1. Welcome and Introductions:
2. Ian Mearns MP welcomed the 90+ attendees to the meeting.
3. **Market Review: in conversation with Ian Bauckham, Chair, Expert Group**
Ian Bauckham outlined the major issues arising from the Market Review. A transcript of this item is attached.
4. **Delivering World Class Teacher Development**
There was a brief discussion on Nick Gibb's detailed response to the critique prepared by Chris Waterman. Concerns remained about the direction of travel¹
5. **"Reimagining Education" update on publication**
Chris Waterman reported that the final draft was with the printer and would be available shortly.
6. **International Qualified Teacher Status (iQTS): Government consultation response**
There was a brief discussion on the iQTS, with a short report from a member of the Expert Group.
7. **Teacher supply update: Tanya Ovenden-Hope**
Tanya spoke briefly to the update from John Howson and her own report.
8. **Chartered College of Teaching update**
Lisa** reported on the work of the CCOT, as Dame Alison Peacock was unable to attend
9. **Instructional Coaching**
There was a brief discussion on Instructional Coaching, and the 'English variant' being promoted by the providers. It was agreed that the ECF and the use of IC would be considered at the next meeting.
10. **'Culture and Education'**
Chris Waterman reported on a seminar on 'Culture and Education' which had been arranged for Monday 16th October 2021. It would dig deeper into the implications of education reforms on the future of children and young people.
